EFASS or Flight Watch

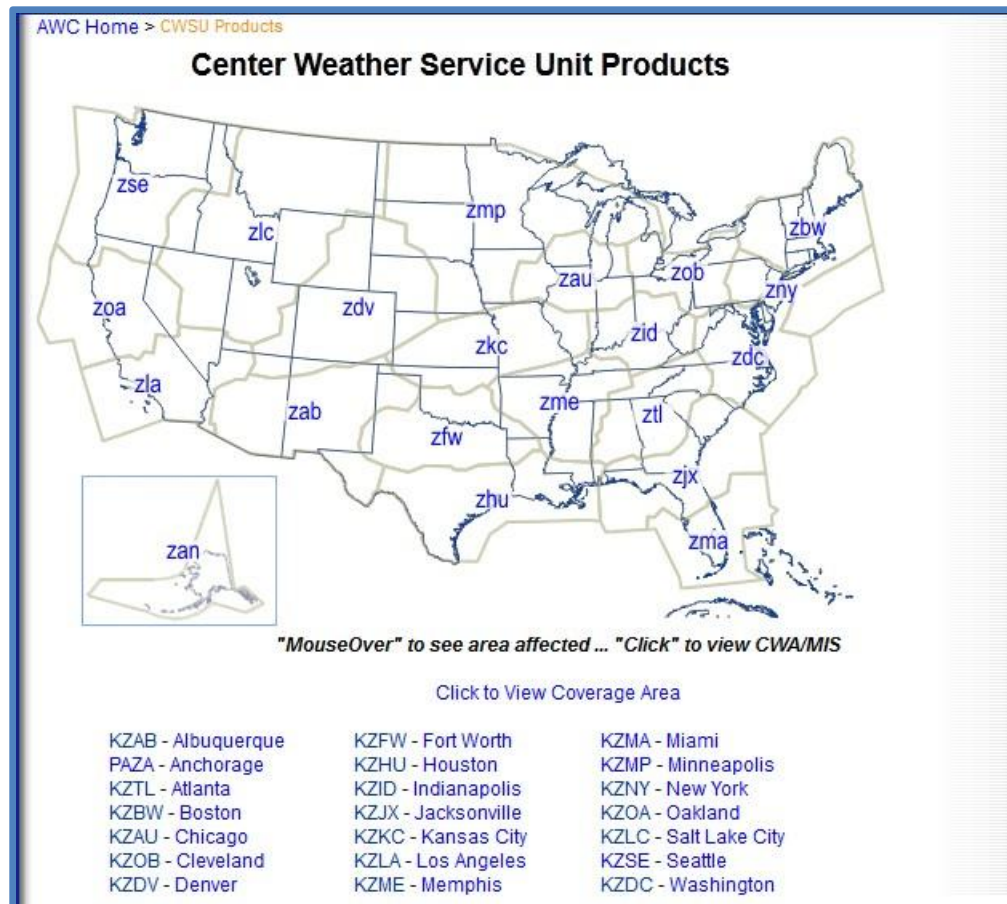
- Standard Frequency 122.0 MHz

TWEB or HIWAS

- Transcribed WX Broadcast is Going the Way of the DoDo Bird
- Use Flight Watch
- Hazardous In-Flight Weather Advisory Service
 - On Selected VORs
 - See H in Upper Right Corner of NAVAID Box

Center WX Advisories (CWA)

- Issued by Air Route Traffic Control Center



AWOS & ASOS

- Automated Weather Observing System
 - Only Current WX
 - 512-353-8005
- Automated Surface Observing System
 - Broadcast over Discrete Frequencies on NAVAID
 - Telephone Interface – See Airport Facility Directory
 - May Have Interface to ATIS – Used When Tower is Closed
